



Hovey Pond Wedding Information

Hovey Pond can be used to host wedding ceremonies during day light hours – there are many locations within the park that are appropriate for weddings – the public gardens, Maine Pavilion, etc. Prior approval is only necessary if you wish to RESERVE MAINE PAVILION – otherwise you can choose a location in which to hold your ceremony. **If you choose to hold your ceremony at Hovey Pond, please remember:**

- The park remains open for public use at ALL times during day light hours
- Use of the pavilion is available first-come first-served, unless it is reserved for the occasion (\$125, non-refundable rental fee)
- Parking is limited and cannot be reserved – a total of 25 parking spots exist at present time
- There are no electricity outlets available anywhere in the park
- No portion of the park can be closed off from public use – except for the pavilion when it has been properly reserved /rented (rental fee paid)
- All decorations must be completely removed once your ceremony is completed
- Tents or other ground anchored, temporary structures are NOT allowed (small pop ups can be used)
- Consumption of alcohol is NOT allowed
- Maine Pavilion has two, six-foot picnic tables that can be easily moved for access - as long as they replaced when finished. The pavilion is 12' x 16' in size
