### Welcome, Campers!

We are so excited you are here! This brochure details our upcoming theme days, special events, and field trips. These field trips and activities are for registered Q-Club campers ages 5-12. Theme days and special events are free for all campers; field trip costs are listed with each trip on the following pages.

### **Field Trip Registration:**

#### Registration for ALL field trips will open on the first day of camp, Monday, July 1, at

**10am.** Field Trip registration will be accepted at the Recreation Department located in the Town Office Building (742 Bay Road, Queensbury) or online at recreation.queensbury.net. Please refer to each trip summary to determine whether the trip is age appropriate for your child. Some trips may not be suitable for all children (i.e.activity type, age limitations, etc.). A wait-list will be created when there are more campers interested in attending a trip than spots available. Wait-list members will be notified by 4pm the day prior to the trip if their camper has been moved from the wait-list onto the trip.

### Field Trip Registration Deadlines:

Trip registration deadlines are **4pm on the day prior to the scheduled trip**. **REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE TRIP AND ALL PROGRAM FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE ATTENDING A TRIP. Payments can be made with cash, credit card, or check** (made payable to the Town of Queensbury).

We politely request that you do not send your camper with additional spending money; the listed fee covers all elements of each trip. Q-Club staff members are not held responsible for lost money on trips.

### Field Trip Transportation:

Children who participate in Q-Club field trips must ride to and from the scheduled activity on the Q-Club bus. With the exception of the Gurney Lane Swim and Night Watch trips, children are not allowed to be dropped off or picked up from the location of the field trip.

Field Trip T-Shirt: It is our goal to provide a safe environment for all children when visiting a field trip destination. Wearing a **NEON YELLOW** t-shirt makes a difference for the staff to identify all Q-Club children on the trip **NEON YELLOW** Q-Club shirts are available for purchase (\$10 each) at camp; we accept cash or checks made payable to the Town of Queensbury.

### **Field Trip Refund Policy:**

Refunds will only be issued if the cancellation is requested 48 hours *before the trip*. A \$5.00 cancellation fee, per trip, per child will be applied to all refund requests made. In the event that the department cancels a trip for any reason, or when there is no rain date scheduled, a full refund will be issued.

### Field Trip Rain-Date Policy:

In the event of predicted inclement weather, a cancellation will be made and communicated at 5pm on the day prior to the trip and the rain date will be used.
