



FIELD TRIPS & PROGRAM INFO

Monday-Friday, July 3-August 18, 2023

Field Trip Program Guidelines & Reminders:

The Q-Club field trips and daily activities are for children ages 5-12 years of age. Children that wish to participate in trips or events MUST be registered for Q-Club and have paid the program fee before attending a trip or event. Cost for each trip includes transportation, supervision and admission. We ask that you do not send your camper with additional spending money.

Field Trip Registration:

Field Trip registration will be accepted at the Recreation Department located in the Town Office Building (742 Bay Road, Queensbury) or online at recreation.queensbury.net. Please refer to each trip summary to determine whether the trip is age appropriate for your child. Some trips may not be suitable for all children (i.e.activity type, age limitations, etc.) Registration for field trips will open on the first day of camp, Monday July 3, at 10am; all trips will be open at this time. A wait-list will be created when there are more campers interested in attending a trip than spots available. Wait-list members will be notified by 4pm the day prior to the trip if their camper has been moved from the wait-list onto the trip.

Field Trip Registration Deadlines:

Trip registration deadlines are 4:00pm on the day prior to the scheduled trip (unless otherwise noted). REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE TRIP. PAYMENT: CASH, CREDIT CARD, or CHECKS (made payable to the Town of Queensbury) will be accepted.

Field Trip Transportation:

Children who participate in Q-Club field trips or events must ride to and from the scheduled activity on the Q-Club bus. With the exception of the Gurney Lane Cookout and Night Watch trips, children are not allowed to be dropped off or picked up from the location of the field trip.

Field Trip T-Shirt Color: It is our goal to provide a safe environment for all children when visiting a field trip destination. Wearing a **NEON YELLOW** t-shirt makes a difference for the staff to better identify all Q-Club children participating in the trips. **NEON YELLOW** Q-Club t-shirts are available for purchase (\$10 each) at camp. We accept cash or checks made payable to the Town of Queensbury. A Q-Club field trip shirt or other neon yellow shirt are both acceptable. Your cooperation is appreciated!

Field Trip Refund Policy:

Refunds will only be issued if the cancellation is requested 48 hours *before the trip*. A \$5.00 cancellation fee, per trip, per child will be applied to all refund requests made. In the event that the department cancels a trip for any reason, or when there is no rain date scheduled, a full refund will be issued.

New York State Department of Health Swimming Assessment Requirement:

For all Q-Club trips that involve swimming (i.e. Gurney Lane Cookout & Swim and Night Watch), **each camper** is required to have their swimming ability assessed **once per summer** by the Q-Club Aquatics Director. This is a mandatory requirement by the NYS Department of Health. There are no exceptions to this rule.

Important Reminders:

There will be two snack/drink breaks during the Q-Club day, the first at 10:00am and the second at 11:00am. Please send your child with a labeled (first and last name) snack and drink every day. Children may refill their water bottles up at the water fountain inside the 4/5 school.

NO NUT PRODUCTS PLEASE

Q-Club Staff are not responsible for any lost or stolen items. This includes toys, trading cards, apparel, cell phones, jewelry, electronic devices, costumes and props associated with theme days or other activities. Cell phones must remain in campers' backpacks and can be used only with counselor permission during camp hours. Please label all of your child's accessories and belongings with your child's first and last name! On the last day of camp, all unclaimed Lost & Found items will be donated.
